HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

Omagh Lawn Tennis Club Limited (“OLTC”) is strongly committed to encouraging its members and visitors to take part in sport and social activities but in doing so the health, wellbeing and safety of each individual is always a paramount concern. The OLTC Committee recognises their responsibility and as far as is reasonably practical, will endeavour to reduce risks to their lowest levels, compatible with the enjoyment of the activity.

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

To support our Health and Safety policy statement we are committed to the following duties:

- Undertake regular, recorded risk assessments of the club premises and all activities undertaken by the club.
- Create a safe environment by putting health and safety measures in place as identified by the assessments.
- Ensure that all members and facility users are aware of and follow the club’s health and safety policy.
- Appoint a competent club member to assist with health and safety responsibilities.
- Ensure that normal operating procedures and emergency operating procedures are in place and known by all members and facility users.
- Provide access to adequate first aid facilities.
- Record and, if necessary, report any injuries or accidents sustained during any club activity or whilst on the club premises.
- Ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

AS A CLUB MEMBER/ FACILITY USER YOU HAVE A DUTY TO:

- Take reasonable care of your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or do not do.
- Cooperate with the club on health and safety issues.
- Correctly use all equipment provided by the club.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.
- Immediately report any potential hazards/risks you identify to the Club’s Health & Safety Officer or other Club representative, so that prompt and appropriate action can be taken to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all users.
